Puppy Evaluation/Temperament Test Rules EFFECTIVE April 1 2015

FOR CURRENT CLUB MEMBERS

Members who wish to have puppy evaluations/temperament testing etc. of litters they own at the club will abide by the following rules approved at Board/General Meeting April 1, 2015:

- 1. This should be an educational experience and notification and ability of all members to attend should be encouraged. We learn a LOT about dogs/structure/purpose etc. from observing other breeds.
- 2. Permission and notification from the Board/including a preferred two week notice but at least a week notice.
- Breeder must bring X-pens/paper towels/pee pads etc.
 (Use of club X pens/pee pads -\$10 donation)
- 4. Provide printed copies of the breed standard for observers and temperament test forms (if applicable).
- 5. All soiled papers to be hauled off by breeder.
- 6. ALL DAMAGE TO BE PAID FOR BY MEMBER BRINGING PUPPIES. NO EXCEPTIONS.

FOR NON-MEMBERS:

Non-Members who wish to have puppy evaluations/temperament testing etc. of litters they own at the club will abide by the following rules approved at Board/General Meeting April 1, 2015:

1. This should be an educational experience and notification and ability of all members to attend should be encouraged. We learn a LOT about dogs/structure/purpose etc. from observing other breeds.

Non-Members will need to have a current board approved member present to supervise facility use.

- 2. Permission and notification from the Board/including a preferred two week notice but at least a week notice.
- Breeder must bring X-pens/paper towels/pee pads etc.

- 4. Provide printed copies of the breed standard for observers and temperament test forms (if applicable).
- 5. A donation of (\$50 per hour) for club use will be charged.
- 6. All soiled papers to be hauled off by breeder.
- 7. ALL DAMAGE TO BE PAID FOR BY NON-MEMBER BRINGING PUPPIES. NO EXCEPTIONS.
